* Adjunct faculty may continue as a student's advisor, with approval from the Associate Dean for Graduate Education and Research, if the initial assignment as advisor occurred during his/her full-time faculty appointment. Adjunct faculty may not serve as newly appointed advisors. In all cases of adjuncts serving as doctoral advisor, the request and the Associate Dean's permission should be documented in the student's file.

** Either one Scientist track or one Adjunct may serve on a committee, but not both.

An advisor must have an active primary or joint appointment in the student's department.

Emeriti Professors may serve as doctoral advisors or as Chair.

Although visiting faculty have full time appointments, they may not serve as doctoral advisors.
