Yash Gupta is an innovative educator and visionary leader who served as dean at three prominent business schools prior to his appointment as inaugural dean of The Johns Hopkins University Carey Business School on January 1, 2008. He has published more than 130 articles in refereed and peer reviewed journals and in 1994 and 1996 was ranked the most prolific scholar in the area of operations management in the United States. In 1991, he received the University of Louisville President's Award for Outstanding Scholarship, Research and Creative Activity. Dr. Gupta's research has been cited more than 1,000 times in business, medical, and other scholarly publications. Research grants include awards from the AT&T Foundation, General Electric, Alliant Health Systems, and the Bell South Foundation.

As dean of the University of Southern California's Marshall School of Business from 2004 to 2006, Dr. Gupta developed an innovation-focused MBA curriculum; increased emphasis on faculty research; created research centers for global business, bio-business, sports business, and brand management; and expanded the faculty. His deanship at the University of Washington Business School from 1999 to 2004 produced new initiatives in technology entrepreneurship and commercialization, and a globally-focused MBA program. Dr. Gupta also headed the College of Business and Administration at the University of Colorado at Denver from 1992 to 1999.

Additional appointments include the Frazier Family Professor in the School of Business at the University of Louisville, professor at the University of Manitoba, and assistant professor at Memorial University of Newfoundland. During his career, Dr. Gupta has held joint appointments in departments of industrial engineering, mechanical engineering, engineering mathematics, and computer science.

Yash Gupta currently serves on the governing board of the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB), the longest-serving and largest global accrediting body for business schools in the world. He earned a Ph.D. in management sciences from the University of Bradford in England, and a master's degree in production management from Brunel University, West London.
