We want a way to truly engage our volunteers, make volunteering with us a meaningful experience, develop your knowledge, give you leadership opportunities, and create a volunteer system that allows you to choose how you participate.

How it works:

Volunteers can participate at three levels:

- **Community Liaison** - *staffing a table at health fairs or community events, providing information, literature, and education*
- **Community Presenter** - *giving presentations to parent groups, community associations, conducting direct education for at-risk populations*
- **Community Health Leader** - *the full range of volunteer options are available to you: testifying and advocating, helping develop outreach programs, educating other volunteers, giving presentations, staffing tables.*

Each level requires a different number of training hours. The more trainings you attend, the more you learn and the more you build towards becoming a Community Health Leader.

| Level | Training Hours | Required Classes |
|-------------------------------------|----------------|------------------|
| Community Health Leader (Level III) | 12.0 | 1,2, 3,4, 5, 6 |
| Community Presenter (Level II) | 6.0 | 1, 2, 3 |
| Community Liaison (Level I) | 2.0 | 1 |
