Student Health Insurance Policies

- All full-time and international students are required to have health insurance.
- The policy period for new full-time students beginning classes during summer term and all continuing students is July 1 through June 30.
- The policy period for new full-time students beginning classes during 1st term is September 1 through June 30.
- Part-time students have the option of enrolling during the open enrollment period only (July and September).
- If any student (full-time, part-time, post-doctoral fellow) registers at the School for the first time during a month other than July or September, they may enroll in the plan during that same month. If it is after the 10th of the month, they will be enrolled the following month.
- Once a student is enrolled in the plan, they must stay enrolled through June 30 unless they are no longer registered at the School.
- Health insurance premiums for each term will be posted to their student account beginning the month they enroll in the plan.
- If the student is no longer enrolled at the School, their insurance will be terminated for the *term(s)* they are not registered.

Summer – July, August
1st Term – Sept, Oct
2nd Term – Nov, Dec

3rd Term – Jan, Feb, March
4th Term – April, May, June

- The Student Accounts Office must be notified by the 10th of the month, no exceptions, for a change in coverage. The student can make a change in coverage only for a life event; marriage, divorce, birth or loss of coverage on another plan.
- In the event of a birth, the child must be added in the month of their birth date. The premium for adding this child must be paid for that entire month.
- Once a student is no longer enrolled at the School, they may continue their coverage under COBRA for up to 18 months. They must notify the Students Accounts Office in writing within 60 days if they wish to extend their coverage.
- The student is responsible for terminating their coverage.
