

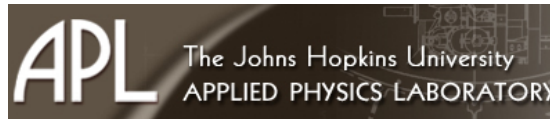
## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:
