

Gates Institute International Internship Opportunities

The Gates Institute offers five 3-6 month internship opportunities for continuing MHS and doctoral **students in the Bloomberg School of Public Health**. The goal of the internship program is to provide students with practical experience in the field of population and reproductive health in developing countries. The 3-6 month internship may be conducted with the Gates Institute's collaborating institutions overseas (<http://www.jhsph.edu/gatesinstitute/PL/InstitutionalPrograms>).

While priority consideration will be given to students in the Population, Family and Reproductive Health (PFRH) Department, students from other Departments in the School who have demonstrated interest in the areas of population, family planning and reproductive health can also apply. It is anticipated that up to five internships of up to \$5000 will be awarded each academic year.

It is **recommended** that internships should be identified and arranged in conjunction with the Gates Institute and its partner institutions. Students must have pre-arranged the internship prior to submitting their applications. Interested students should submit a brief description of the project they intend to work on with their application. A Hopkins faculty member must also agree to co-accept the internship along with an appropriate counterpart at the collaborating institution. If the Hopkins faculty preceptor is not the student's academic advisor, that advisor must also provide signed concurrence on the internship. **All students receiving support for internships are expected to submit a mid-term report and a final report at the end of their internship.** Recipient of an award is required to present on his/her project either at a Gates Institute or PFRH departmental seminar.

Application Procedure

Internship applications will be accepted twice per academic year. There is an October 1st deadline and an April 1st deadline for the receipt of applications. First year masters students are expected to apply for the **April 1st** deadline. Applications should be submitted to the Gates Institute Academic Training Coordinator, Dr. Gbolahan Oni (goni@jhsph.edu). All applications will be reviewed by the Training Committee of the Gates Institute.
