## **Problem Solving in Public Health**

Miriam Alexander, MD, MPH has been a public health professional for over two decades, with expertise in maternal and child nutrition, occupational health, and preventive medicine. Dr. Alexander began her career in the Baltimore City Health Department as the director of the preschool health services, and went on to become the medical director for occupational health services at Bethlehem Steel and for McCormick and Co. In 1995, Dr. Alexander joined the faculty at Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health where she is the director of the General Preventive Medicine Residency program and of the Mid-Atlantic Public Health Training Center. From 2004-2007, she directed the Hopkins Urban Health Institute efforts at providing free clinical services to the uninsured of east Baltimore. She received her MD from Cornell University in 1984 and an MPH from Johns Hopkins in 1988. She is President-elect of the American College of Preventive Medicine.
