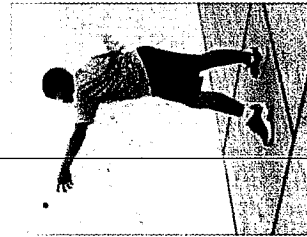
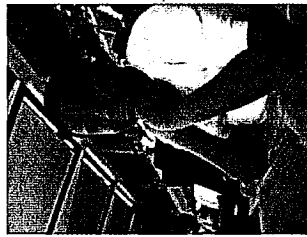


History of Urban Squash

Baltimore SquashWise is based on the successful model of urban squash & education programs, starting with Boston's SquashBusters in 1996. Similar programs now operate in New York, Chicago, Washington, D.C., New Haven, San Diego, and Philadelphia.

- 100% of participants graduate from high school.
 - 93% of participants earn a college degree.
 - \$4 million in high school scholarships have been awarded to 40 "urban squashers" across the country.
- The National Urban Squash & Education Association assists new programs like ours to achieve equally successful outcomes.

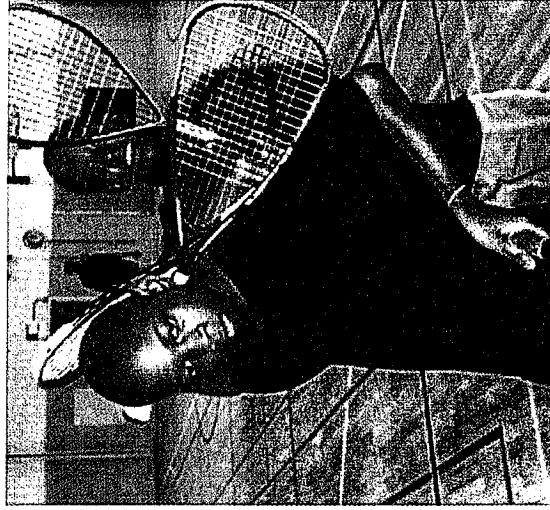
Booker T. Washington Middle School

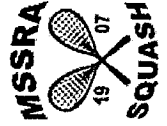
Partnerships

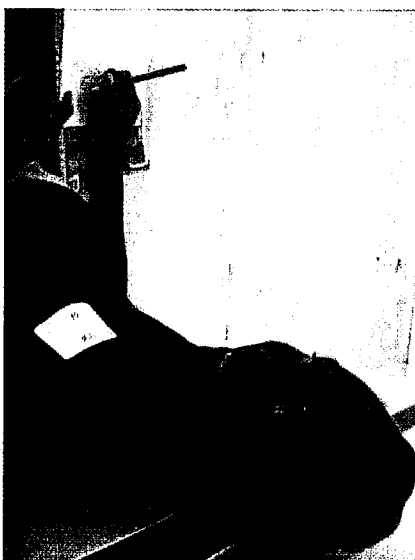
