SquashWise is a nonprofit organization providing middle school students from Baltimore City with a safe and structured place to exercise their bodies and minds during the afterschool hours. We combine squash instruction, academic tutoring, mentoring and community service to empower local youth to excel academically, athletically and in life. We are based on the very successful model of urban squash & education popular in 8 cities.

Job Description

- Recruitment Intern will collaborate with SquashWise staff and other area interns to recruit academic tutors and squash volunteers
- Interns will plan and execute fundraising events at their school or community to raise awareness for SquashWise
- Interns will assist with organizing opportunities and partnerships between the intern's school and the SquashWise program.
- Interns will serve as a liaison to students to help create a core group of tutors and squash volunteers to support the SquashWise program throughout the school year.
- The intern will be responsible for getting their school and community excited and involved with the SquashWise program!

The schedule is flexible, with some office hours and weekend commitments required

- Minimum education requirement: Current High school or College student
- Excellent interpersonal, writing, and communication skills.
- Excellent time management skills.
- Experience working with youth, especially at-risk youth.
- Squash experience is not required, but an interest in squash and sports is a plus.
- Pass a criminal history background check (if over 18).
