Gareth Williams is former Dean and current Professor of Medicine and Dentistry at the University of Bristol and serves as Lead for European Relations in the Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry. He is Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Edward Jenner Museum, Gloucestershire, England. He has written 200 scientific papers and has authored or edited over 20 books, including the prize-winning Textbook of Diabetes. In 2009, he wrote *Angel of Death: the Story of Smallpox*, which was shortlisted for the prestigious Wellcome Trust Book Prize. Gareth is a former President of the Anglo-French Medical Society and was awarded an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Angers.
