

SECTION 380.110: OPERATORS AND PASSENGERS TO WEAR HELMETS A. It shall be unlawful for: 1. Any person to operate or be a passenger on a bicycle, scooter, roller skates, roller blades or skateboard unless such person shall wear protective headgear which properly fits and is fastened securely upon the head of the operator or passenger, and 2. A parent or guardian to permit a child under the age of seventeen (17) years to operate or be a passenger on such devices without wearing properly fitted headgear. B. The required headgear shall meet or exceed the impact standards for protective bicycle helmets set by the U. S. Consumer Products Safety Commission, the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), the Snell Memorial Foundation or the American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM). (Vil. Ord. SECTION 380.130: PENALTIES Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Chapter shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Provided, however, that any parent or guardian found to be in violation of Section 380.110 may be issued an equipment violation notice as prescribed on a Missouri Uniform Complaint and Summons, which violation may be dismissed if the parent or guardian brings an approved helmet to the Grantwood Village Police Department within twenty five (25) working days of the receipt of the violation and receives compliance verification as set forth on the back of the Missouri Uniform Complaint and Summons.
