Jonca Bull, M.D., serves as Vice President and Strategic Regulatory Advisor for Global Product Development at PPD. Based in PPD's Washington, D.C., area office, Dr. Bull joined PPD in 2017 following a career with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and in the pharmaceutical industry, working across a range of therapeutic areas and indications. Prior to joining PPD, Dr. Bull served as an assistant commissioner at FDA with focus on clinical trials and demographic inclusion; vice president for U.S./North American regulatory policy for Novartis Pharmaceuticals; and director of clinical regulatory policy for Genentech. From 1994 to 2005, Dr. Bull held various senior leadership roles with the FDA across various disease areas and programs, addressing pre and post-marketing issues. From 1982 to 1994 she cared for patients in a large medical/surgical practice in the Washington metro area. She is a diplomat of both the American Board of Ophthalmology and the National Board of Medical Examiners.

Dr. Bull holds an undergraduate degree from Princeton University, a medical degree from Duke University, and she completed residencies in general medicine and ophthalmology at George Washington University Hospital in Washington, D.C., where she also serves as an assistant clinical professor.
