Distracted Driving

- Teamsters Union represents nearly 600,000 commercial drivers in the U.S.

Distracted Driving

- Union conducts training seminars for business agents and rank and file membership
 - Regulatory updates
 - Legislative
 - Collective bargaining agreements
 - Amendments to CBAs
 - Enforcement of new contractual provisions

Distracted Driving

- Driver Feedback
 - Frustration that they are perceived as being the primary causes of distraction-related crashes
 - More focus on non-commercial drivers
 - Use cell phones and CB radios to stay alert/awake during nighttime driving
 - Feel pressure to increase productivity
